4 HOME-BASED LEARNING (HBL) DAY for Sec 2 & 3

HBL is an essential component of our students' learning experiences as it strengthens their ability to be self-directed, independent and lifelong learners. With the introduction of Personal Learning Devices, our Sec 2 to 4 students now own a Chromebook, which they use in tandem with the Singapore Student Learning Space (SLS), Google Classroom and other educational technology to personalise and enhance their learning.

For Sec 2 and 3, the HBL day will be on the **Wednesday** of the **even week**.

5 STUDENT HANDBOOK AND REMINDER OF SCHOOL RULES

We wish to highlight five important school rules that we emphasize to our students at the start of each year.

- Students who are Singapore citizens must sing the National Anthem and take the Pledge (with the right fist placed over the heart).
- Students must wear the prescribed school uniform and no modification to the uniform is allowed. All students must wear white socks and white-based shoes.
- Tinted or dyed hair is strictly not allowed. All male students must be neat and clean shaven.
- All students should not have in their possession any weapon. They are not allowed to bring any weapon-like item which is used or intended to be used to cause harm to others.
- Students are not allowed to use the mobile devices during curriculum time so as to avoid disruption to learning. They may use these devices after curriculum hours at designated areas, e.g canteen. Should they break the rule, their mobile devices will be confiscated and may only be collected by the parent.

Details of our school rules can be found in the Student Handbook. You may also wish to check your child's Handbook for important information such as homework, test and examination dates, as well as use it to communicate with your child's Group Parent.

6 TERM BREAK

Term 1 break is from **12 Mar to 20 Mar**. We hope that you will assist your child to make good use of the one-week break to improve on his/her academic performance. Holiday assignments will be given to your child and we would appreciate it if you could assist in ensuring that your child completes his/her work for submission on the first day of Term 2. Our Graduating students doing coursework in D&T, F&N, Art and EBS may be required by their teachers to be in school to complete part of their coursework. The teachers will inform your child of the dates.

If your child/ward is travelling out of Singapore during the above period, please declare their travelling plans by completing the Travel Declaration module found on the Parents Gateway (PG) app. Should you not have access to PG, please get your child/ward to obtain a hardcopy form from the School General Office.
