6. SUSPENSION OF CCA (14 SEP – 7 OCT)

All CCAs will be suspended from **14 Sep – 7 Oct** to enable students to focus on their End-of-Year Examinations.

7. NEW ACADEMIC YEAR 2017

The new term in 2017 will start on **3 Jan 2017**. All students are expected to return to school on the 1st day with their new textbooks and in their full school uniform with neat appearance and appropriate hairstyle as reflected in the student handbook. No facial hair is permitted. There should be no modifications made to the uniform.

Students must purchase their textbooks and workbooks for 2017 during the holidays from the school bookshop. Details of the dates of purchase will be put up at the bookshop before the end of the term.

8. STUDENT NAMETAGS

Please note that it is **mandatory** for all students to have their nametags sewn on to their uniforms. Our school bookshop is supplying the fabrication of the nametags. There will be a **one-off exercise** for students who have misplaced their nametags or wish to order new ones to place their order with their GPs by **the second week of Term 4**. Subsequently students who lose their nametags will have to order from a private vendor at a higher cost.
